TITLE: CONCERNING A REQUIREMENT THAT THE LOCATION OF A PRIVATE BURIAL BE RECORDED.**Summary of Legislation**

The bill requires the owner of the land used for a private burial to provide the following information to the county clerk within 30 days of a burial:

- the name, date of birth, and age at death of the person buried;
- the name of the property owner;
- the legal description of the property;
- the reception number for the death certificate; and
- the latitude and longitude coordinates of the burial site, which have been verified by witnesses or the sheriff.

The bill takes effect August 11, 2010, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 12, 2010, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.

Assessment

The bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact. It clarifies the recording procedures for private burials. By providing the required information to the county clerks, they will be able to better track where private burials have occurred. It is not expected to increase the workload for county governments.
