TITLE: CONCERNING THE DUTIES OF THE ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY POVERTY
REDUCTION TASK FORCE.**Summary of Legislation**

The bill, recommended by the Economic Opportunity Poverty Reduction Task Force, adds developing a model for ongoing assessment of progress towards reducing poverty and increasing economic opportunity in Colorado to the task force's duties. A subcommittee of the task force is responsible for creating the model. Once developed, the task force is required to recommend this model to the General Assembly for adoption in measuring the effectiveness of certain public programs and policies in meeting the poverty reduction goals of the task force.

The Governor signed the bill into law on April 15, 2010, and unless a referendum petition is filed, the bill will take effect August 11, 2010.

Assessment

The bill is assessed at no fiscal impact. The bill expands the duties of the task force. However, these new responsibilities are assigned to a subcommittee of a task force whose members serve without compensation or reimbursement of expenses. Therefore, the bill is not expected to have an impact on legislative staff workload or costs.
