TITLE: CONCERNING THE BOUNDARIES OF FOREST IMPROVEMENT DISTRICTS.**Summary of Legislation**

Under current law, the governing board of a county or municipality may propose the creation of a forest improvement district only if the boundaries of the new district include the entire territory of the county or municipality. This bill allows for the creation of a forest improvement district whose boundaries that do not necessarily coincide with a county or municipality. Further, the district boundary may consist of noncontiguous tracts or parcels of property.

The bill is effective upon signature of the Governor.

Assessment

The bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact. Forest improvement district boundary changes will not alter the procedural or administrative duties of the county assessor or county treasurer where a district may be located. It should be noted that currently no forest improvement districts are located within the state.
