TITLE: CONCERNING INFORMATION-SHARING AT COLORADO STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION.**Summary of Legislation**

This bill allows police departments at state institutions of higher education to share information concerning individuals who demonstrate behavior that may pose a risk to the campus community. Information may be shared with administrators for campus programs responsible for victims assistance, mental health services, university housing, student affairs, a campus task force or any individual who is the focus of a specific threat. It also removes civil liability for certain individuals who provide public safety related information. The bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on April 20, 2011.

Assessment

This bill is a procedural change, which does not affect state expenditures or revenues. It is therefore assessed as having no fiscal impact.
