**Summary of Legislation**

This bill, adopted by the Transportation Legislation Review Committee, repeals certain transportation and energy-related reports required to be submitted by the Departments of Public Health and Environment, Transportation, and Revenue to various committees of the General Assembly, including the House and Senate Transportation Committees, and the Transportation Legislation Review Committee.

**State Expenditures**

By eliminating certain reporting requirements, the bill will reduce staff workload for the Departments of Public Health and Environment, Transportation, and Revenue. However, the reduction in workload is minimal and will not require an adjustment in appropriations for any state agency.
