TITLE: CONCERNING THE ABILITY OF A LOCAL GOVERNMENT TO PERMIT, IN ITS DISCRETION, THE COLLECTION OF CHARITABLE SOLICITATIONS FROM MOTORISTS ON A CERTAIN NUMBER OF DAYS PER CALENDAR YEAR.

Summary of Legislation

This bill allows local governments to grant permission to charitable organizations to solicit donations on public roadways. The area of solicitation must be wholly within the jurisdiction of the local government providing the permission. Permission cannot be granted more than five times per year. The bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect March 22, 2012.

Assessment

The bill may require local governments to consider and process permissions, but it will not have a significant fiscal impact.
