Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Under existing law, each local education provider must administer the state assessments in math and English language arts to ninth-grade students and must administer a state-selected assessment to tenth-grade students. The bill repeals the requirement to administer the state assessment to ninth-grade students. Instead, local education providers must administer a state-selected ninth-grade assessment that is aligned with the ninth-grade content standards and the assessment administered to tenth-grade students. The department of education must ensure that, under the testing schedule, ninth-grade students take the state-selected assessment in the spring semester.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:* 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-7-1006.3, amend 3 (1)(a)(I), (2)(a), and (10); **repeal** (1)(b); and **add** (2)(a.5) as follows: 4 22-7-1006.3. State assessments - administration - rules. 5 (1) (a) Beginning in the 2015-16 school year, the department of 6 education, in collaboration with local education providers, shall 7 administer the state assessments in the instructional areas of English 8 language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies, as adopted by the 9 state board pursuant to section 22-7-1006, as follows: 10 (I) The department shall administer a state assessment in English 11 language arts and a state assessment in mathematics to all students 12 enrolled in grades three through nine EIGHT in public schools throughout 13 the state. 14 (b) As soon as practicable after May 20, 2015, the department of 15 education shall apply to the federal department of education for a waiver 16 of federal statutory and regulatory requirements as may be necessary to 17 allow the department to satisfy the federal high school assessment 18 requirements by administering assessments in English language arts and 19 mathematics to students enrolled in ninth grade. 20 (2) (a) The department of education shall select and the state shall 21 pay the costs of administering an assessment that is aligned with the state 22 academic standards for students enrolled in tenth NINTH grade and with 23 the assessment selected pursuant to paragraph (b) of this subsection (2)

1 SUBSECTION (2)(a.5) OF THIS SECTION. Every five years, the department 2 shall request competitive bids and contract for the assessment required in 3 this paragraph (a). Each local education provider shall administer the 4 assessment for students enrolled in tenth grade. Each local education 5 provider shall administer the tenth-grade assessment on a schedule that 6 the department annually sets SUBSECTION (2)(a). THE DEPARTMENT SHALL 7 ANNUALLY SCHEDULE A DAY DURING THE SPRING SEMESTER ON WHICH 8 EACH LOCAL EDUCATION PROVIDER SHALL ADMINISTER THE NINTH-GRADE 9 ASSESSMENT TO ALL STUDENTS ENROLLED IN NINTH GRADE IN THE STATE. 10 (a.5) THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SHALL SELECT AND THE 11 STATE SHALL PAY THE COSTS OF ADMINISTERING AN ASSESSMENT THAT IS 12 ALIGNED WITH THE STATE ACADEMIC STANDARDS FOR STUDENTS 13 ENROLLED IN TENTH GRADE AND WITH THE ASSESSMENT SELECTED 14 PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (2)(b) OF THIS SECTION. EVERY FIVE YEARS, 15 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUEST COMPETITIVE BIDS AND CONTRACT FOR 16 THE ASSESSMENT REQUIRED IN THIS SUBSECTION (2)(a.5). EACH LOCAL 17 EDUCATION PROVIDER SHALL ADMINISTER THE ASSESSMENT FOR 18 STUDENTS ENROLLED IN TENTH GRADE. EACH LOCAL EDUCATION 19 PROVIDER SHALL ADMINISTER THE TENTH-GRADE ASSESSMENT ON A 20 SCHEDULE THAT THE DEPARTMENT ANNUALLY SETS. 21 (10) For each fiscal year, the general assembly shall appropriate 22 moneys MONEY in the annual general appropriation act to the department 23 of education to fund administration of the state assessments as described 24 in this section, including administration of the NINTH-GRADE 25 ASSESSMENT, THE tenth-grade assessment, and the curriculum-based, 26 achievement college entrance exam described in subsection (2) of this 27 section.
