This bill requires school districts to provide additional information in school performance reports regarding the availability of courses covering basic life skills, such as financial literacy, nutrition, and wellness. This bill will create a minimal

workload increase for school districts to compile this information.

Appropriation Summary:

No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status:

This fiscal note reflects the introduced bill. The bill was not enacted into law;

therefore, the impacts identified in this analysis do not take effect.

Summary of Legislation

This bill requires school districts to provide additional information in school performance reports that are submitted to the Colorado Department of Education (CDE) regarding the availability of courses related to basic life skills, such as financial literacy, health and wellness, and automotive education.

Local Government (School District)

School districts will incur minimal workload increases to compile this information and report the results to CDE.

Effective Date

The bill was lost on third reading in the House of Representatives on February 12, 2019.
