LABOR & EMPLOYMENT STATUTES TECHNICAL CHANGES

No fiscal impact. The bill makes technical changes to statutes related to labor and employment without substantive changes in policy or practice. The bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Status:

Summary of Legislation

The bill makes technical changes to statute without substantive changes to policy or practice. Notably, this bill removes obsolete statutory references, removes unnecessary language to clarify the allowable use of grant funding from the Immigration Legal Defense Fund, and corrects inconsistencies regarding the membership of two committees: the apprentice committee for building and construction trades, and the apprentice committee for new and emerging industries.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The technical changes in the bill do not substantively change any policy or practice, and will not change the revenue or expenditures of any state agency or local government. For this reason, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor and it took effect on March 22, 2024.
